# Global Cholera Cases and Deaths Reported to the World Health Organization, 1970 to 2004

### Description

Annual cases and deaths from cholera are shown here for all continental regions, along with the number of countries reporting. Cholera is one of many waterborne diseases that are a consequence of the lack of sanitation services and access to clean drinking water. Some data on cholera cases and deaths are available as early as 1922 from reports to the League of Nations, but consistent reports are available from World Health Organization (WHO) since 1950 only. The data here are given annually from 1970 to 2004, with a sum of total cases for Asia from 1950 to 1969.

Figure DT 14.1 and Figure DT 14.2 show the annual number of deaths and total cases from 1970 to 2004. These data clearly reflect the rapid and severe spread of cholera in Latin America during the seventh pandemic, starting with the appearance of cholera in Peru in 1991 and spreading rapidly. That sharp spike in cholera was the first manifestation of the seventh pandemic in the Americas (defined as North, Central, and South America and the Caribbean) and was the first time that the Americas has seen more than a handful of indigenous cases in over a century. Figure DT 14.3 shows the total number of countries reporting to the WHO. As shown, the number has fluctuated over time and has dropped significantly in recent years, which may have an important role in the quality of the overall totals (see Limitations).

### Limitations

These data are only the cases identified and reported to the WHO and do not include undiagnosed or unreported cases. The number of countries reporting cholera cases and deaths increased in Asia in the 1960s and 1970s, declining in the 1980s and then peaking in the 1990s. The number of countries reporting in the past five years is far below the peak, suggesting that totals shown in the table and figures could seriously underrepresent total cholera cases and deaths.



FIGURE DT 14.1 Reported global cholera deaths, 1970-2004.



**Global Cholera Cases Reported 1970 to 2004**
